Class 1 – Novice – 1’9’’ – Aimed at juniors on lead rein or just off and novice/ nervous riders. To be held in gymkhana ring using WH fences & very mini XC jumps.

Class 2 – Intermediate – 2’3’’ – Junior & Senior

Class 3 – Open – Max 2’9’’ (Most fences are 2’6’’) Junior & Senior

Eventathon Rules:

An optimum time will be set for the Cross Country section (this will be displayed prior to the start of each class), the closest competitor to the optimum time with a clear round or least number of faults will be the winner.

**4 Seconds will be added for each show jump fence knocked down or any refusal.
3 refusals = elimination**

Cross country Penalties

First disobedience at a jump	20 penalties
Second disobedience at the same jump	40 penalties
Third disobedience at the same jump	Elimination
Fourth disobedience on the whole course	Elimination
Fall of rider at a fence	65 penalties
Second fall of rider on the course	Elimination
Fall of pony/horse at a fence	Elimination
Every commenced period of 1 second in excess of the optimum time	0.4 penalties
Every commenced period of 1 second in excess of 15 seconds under the optimum time.	0.4 penalties
Exceeding the time limit (cross-country)	Elimination
Error of course (omission of jump, boundary flag, not rectified, retaking an obstacle already jumped	Elimination
Jumping an obstacle in the wrong order.....	Elimination
Jumping an obstacle with crossed flags	Elimination
Trapped pony/horse	Elimination
Inappropriate or dangerous riding.....	Discretionary 25 penalties
Riding improperly dressed	Discretionary Elimination
Starting early.....	Discretionary Elimination

All competitors will be expected to wear a hat conforming to PAS015 and carrying the BSI kitemark whilst mounted.

A Body Protector and Medical Armband must also be worn by all competitors.

Horses and ponies of any height may compete but they must be 4yrs or over.

Junior Riders are those under 18yrs on 01/01/2016 riding a pony not bigger than 148cm.

If a Junior rides a horse bigger than 148cm they must be 13yrs or over and compete in the Senior section.

Neither the committee nor anyone acting on their behalf accepts any responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, howsoever caused.

Dogs are allowed but must be kept on a lead at all times as the course will use the majority of our 12acre site and strict control will be required to ensure safety.

Extra H/C Rounds may be allowed after the competition at £10/Round
