## General Rules:-

- o All competitors will be expected to wear a hat conforming to PAS015 or BSEN1384 and carrying the BSI Kitemark whilst mounted.
- o A Body Protector and Medical Armband must also be worn by all competitors.
- o Junior Riders are those under **16yrs** on 01/01/2016.
- o Junior Riders may ride ponies / horses of any height but they must be 4yrs or over.
- o Senior Riders may ride horses / ponies of any height but they must be 4yrs or over.
- o The course will not be timed in total however it will include a timed section for all classes which will involve opening and closing a gate. The fastest time taken to complete this section will determine the winner in the event of equal jumping penalties.
- o Combinations for the Pairs Classes can be made up of Juniors, Seniors or both.
- o The Pairs Classes will also include a dressing fence, where a mark will be given for competitors style and togetherness.
- o Neither the committee nor anyone acting on their behalf accepts any responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, howsoever caused.
- o Dogs are allowed but must be kept on a lead at all times as the course will use the majority of our 12 acre site and strict control will be required to ensure safety.

Horseware & Eland Lodge hope that this series will appeal to riders of all levels and would like to give them the chance to ride at a championship event – the finals course will be at least 2miles long, over undulating terrain and up to height.
