RULES

- This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Rule Book and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below: <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-rulebook>
- **All entrants must pay a prelim entry of £28 per team or £9 per individual to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Please note only one competitor per test will qualify when using more than one arena Appendix 11 in the rulebook will be applied to resolve the qualifying place. Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries www.britishridingclubs.org.uk or online entries can be made via the BHS bookshop www.britishhorse.com. Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.**
- If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.
- All hats must have a visible orange BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current rule book.
- Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.
- Classes 3 & 4 are only open to current Area 5 BRC members.
- Classes 1 & 2 are warm up classes only and will be judged by a different judge to the Qualifier Classes 3 & 4. In the event of large entries in classes 3 & 4 these warm up classes may be cancelled.

ENTRIES

- Please state clearly on your entry form which day you are entering.
- All entries to be made in writing, all Qualifier class entries to be made on official BRC area entry form (attached)
British Riding Club Members Entry Fees are £11.00 per individual, £44 per team. **(You must state on entry form which Riding Club you are registered with or an additional charge will be incurred.)**
- Anyone who wishes to enter classes 1 or 2 (or both) who are not BRC members, the entry fee will be £12.00 per class.
- In the event of oversubscription to classes, BRC entries will take priority.
- Entries for all **Junior** classes close prompt on **Monday 23rd January 2017** and **Senior** classes close on **Monday 30th January 2017**
